Notice to all BWA Member Cities and Customers:

The effects of Hurricane Beryl has affected our community in many ways but our water remains safe for consumption. Brazosport Water Authority is aware of the taste, color, and odor issues that are affecting Member Cities and Customers, but none of these issues have made our water unsafe. The wind, rainfall and debris from Hurricane Beryl has impacted water sources in our community and throughout southeast Texas. Contributing factors include substantial amounts of organic matter and depleted oxygen in the water. This is a regional wide problem that includes reservoirs, creeks, and bayous. In return, this has caused taste, color, and odor issues within the distribution system. BWA is implementing every treatment technique available to The Authority. The natural cycle will also assist in correcting the situation by reintroducing oxygen back into the bodies of water through several natural actions, such as photosynthesis and other aerating processes. BWA has continuous online monitoring and daily bacteriological sampling. All test results have concluded that the water remains safe for consumption. We apologize for any inconvenience. As always, the safety of the public is our main concern, and we will continue to update as changes occur.
